Supervisor Patrick Murphy opened the Public Hearing on the Proposed New York Municipal Home Rule Law and the New York Real Property Tax Law Town of New Albion Local Law No. 1 of 2020 entitled A LOCAL LAW TO CHANGE THE DATE FOR THE TOWN OF NEW ALBION BOARD ASSESSMENT REVIEW TO HEAR COMPLAINTS IN RELATION TO TAX ASSESSMENTS @ 7:04.

Resolution #21 – 2020 – Local Law 1-2020 To Set the Annual Date for Grievance Day to be the First Thursday in June.

On a motion by Councilman Goss, seconded by Councilman Ridall, the following resolution was **ADOPTED** Aye 5 Murphy, Eaton, Goss, Kazmark, Ridall

RESOLVED, to approve Local Law 1-2020 as follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NEW ALBION AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Intent. The intent of this Local Law is to change the date on which the Board of Assessment Review of the Town of New Albion shall meet to hear complaints in relation to tax assessments.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>Authority.</u> Because the Town of New Albion Assessor also serves as the Assessor for the County, with the date for hearing tax assessment complaints currently set forth for the first Monday in June of each year, thereby creating a conflict for the Assessor to appear at the hearings of both such Boards, Real Property Tax Law § 512 (1-a) authorizes the governing body of such an assessing unit to adopt a local law establishing a different date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment Review other than the first Monday in June.

<u>SECTION.</u> Change in Date. By reasoning of the foregoing, the Town of New Albion Board of Assessment Review shall no longer initially hear complaints in relation to tax assessments on the First Monday in June of each year, but shall instead initially hear complaints in relation to tax assessments on the First Thursday in June of each year.

SECTION 3. Filing. This Local Law shall be filed as required by Real Property Tax Law §512 (1-a).

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Severability. The adoption of this Local Law shall in no way otherwise affect the duties and responsibilities of the Assessor or the Board of Assessment Review of the Town of New Albion under any applicable law or regulation.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This local law shall take effect immediately upon the completion of all filing required by the Municipal Home Rule Law or by Real Property Tax Law § 512 (1-a). This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

<u>Code Enforcer:</u> Frank Watson, light activity. The attorney for SAIA regarding the Tower located on New Albion Rd. had sent the Town a FOIL request. The FOIL was fulfilled and we sent them the requested documents and pictures. I spoke with Joe Puma Vice President from WNED-TV (previous tower owner), FCC removed the use of telecommunications tower in 2003. Sold to SAIA Communications in 2006. No active use of the tower since 2003 based on Mr. Puma's testimony and memory.

<u>Highway Dept.</u>: David Rupp, reports with the unusual warm weather the past few weeks the Highway Dept. has been busy with vehicle maintenance on select trucks needing attention. The Town also has been utilizing the fair weather to fill in pot holes from this winter. If the fair weather stays with us, we will begin to rough grade dirt roads and pull in shoulders where able. With the rainy days the Dept. has begun to broom the roads of sand from this winter. The Highway Dept. has been contacting various truck dealers on the replacement of the 2014 Dodge 5500. Progress on the Waverly St. Project has been delayed due to the Coronavirus issues.

Assessor: Kate Harrington, The February report is as follows: Reminders were mailed to all Agricultural Assessment and Senior Citizen Exemption applicants who had not returned their renewal mid-February. This notice reminded applicants that renewals would not be accepted after the deadline. We have been in contact with many exemption applicants who have questions, need help with an application, or submitted incorrect/insufficient information. The assessing Office has also corresponded with several property owners about their assessments and tax bills. Nine property transfers were added for the month January (next page). Thank You.
